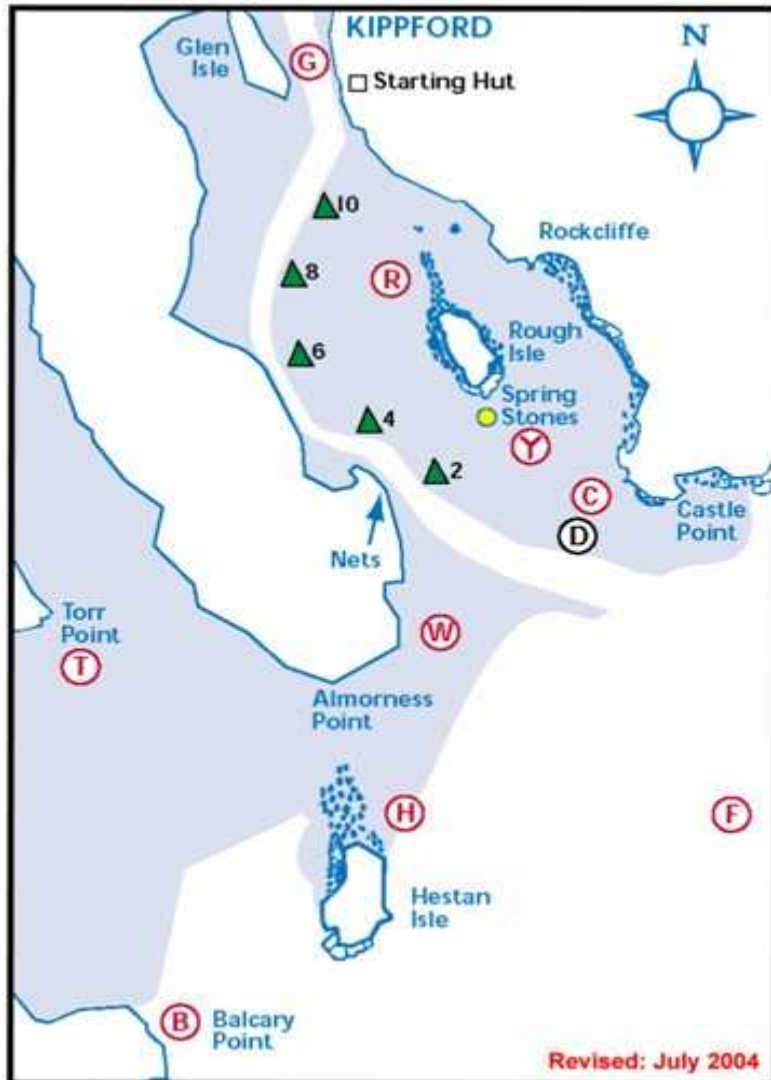

WELCOME

Solway Yacht Club invites you to join us for our annual Cadet Week, offering wonderful sailing in a great environment and in a setting of outstanding natural beauty. Cadet Week is a family friendly series providing competitive racing and after racing social events. It attracts regular competitors from all over Scotland, England and beyond.

The clubhouse is in an elevated position with views over to Glen Isle. The Club site offers excellent launching, pontoons and guest moorings. The estuary dries out but flat areas have been created adjacent the pontoons.

ACCOMMODATION & PARKING

There are many hotels and boarding houses within easy walking or motoring distance as well as caravan, camping and holiday chalets nearby, but early reservations are advised.

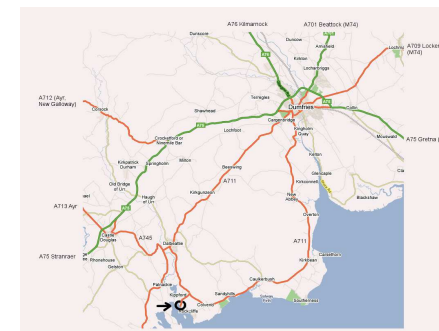
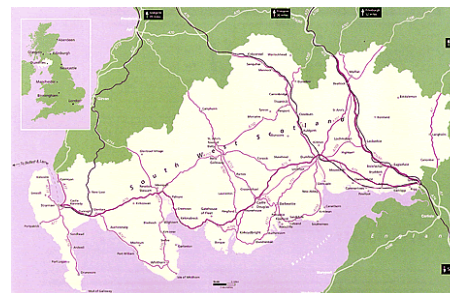
There is limited car parking space at the club site and public car park. Car and other motor transport are not permitted onto the pier area and boat park for competitors safety.

CATERING & BAR

Hot and cold after race catering will be available on all race days and depending on race times may be provided prior to racing. The Club is fully licensed and competitors and visiting members will be elected Honorary Members for the duration of their stay.

CONDITIONS

1. The meeting shall be open to all dinghies, with PN 600 – 1400.
2. The racing will be governed by the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2009-2012, the event Sailing Instructions and the relevant Class Association rules.
3. The entrant shall be deemed to be the Helmsman named on the entry form.
4. Changes of boat can only be notified if in **writing and** with approval of the OOD prior to commencement of the race and not in any case during a series.
5. During the series the crew may be swapped if notified in writing and with approval of the OOD prior to commencement of the race. Helms as indicated on the entry must always be part of the boats crew.
6. Personal buoyancy **must** be worn by all competitors. Boat buoyancy may be subject to scrutiny. Relevant boat(s) should carry an appropriate anchor with at least 10 metres of suitable warp. A painter of 5 metres **must** be carried on all boats.
7. Handicap fleets will be split into fast, medium, slow and Laser Radials according to entries.
8. At the discretion of the Race Committee additional fleet starts may be granted to any class having enough entrants on Saturday 16th July 2011 before the Cadet Week.
9. At the discretion of the Race Committee fleet starts may be withdrawn for any class if there are insufficient entrants.
10. Visitors and competitors are asked to respect the local amenities and residents during their stay at Kippford.
11. Children under 14 are not permitted in the clubhouse after 10pm.
12. Dogs should be kept on a leash at all times.
13. Car numbers should be kept to a minimum and should be parked in club or public car parks and are not allowed on the pier once the series has started.
14. Any alterations to these conditions or other details of this entry form shall be at the sole discretion of the Commodore and Race Committee of Solway Yacht Club.



HOW TO FIND US

The Solway Firth is the stretch of water in south west Scotland between Scotland and England. It is the access to the Irish Sea, Isle of Man and Ireland. The Organising Authority is the Solway Yacht Club, located in the attractive Galloway village of Kippford, 1 mile off the A711, 18 miles south west of Dumfries. The clubhouse and pier/dinghy park are located at the bottom of the hill on entering the village and are very prominent. There is ample dinghy and car parking/trailer space.
